COAA will hold its 6th International Conference on Atmosphere, Ocean, and Climate Change at the Chinese University of Hong Kong on *19-21 August 2013*, HKMS will be a co-organizer. This series of conferences has been a main gathering event of Chinese American oceanic and atmospheric scientists and their colleagues and have been held in U.S., Taiwan, and mainland China.

HKMS will hold the HKMS 25th Anniversary Conference on East Asia and Western Pacific Meteorology and Climate at the Hong Kong University of Science and Technology on *2-4 November 2013*. COAA will be a co-organizer. HKMS was established in 1988 to organize the first of four conferences of the same name between 1989 and 1999.

COAA, the 50th anniversary of Chinese University of Hong Kong, and the 130th anniversary of the Hong Kong Observatory.

With all these anniversaries to celebrate on the agenda, we sincerely look forward to receiving your abstracts/registrations and seeing you in Hong Kong this summer!
