Dr. Qiang Fu received his BS in 1983 and MS in 1985 from Beijing University. He receivQid his Ph.D. in 1991 from University of Utah. Dr. Fu is a full professor at the Department of Atmospheric Sciences, University of Washington since 2006, and an affiliated professor in the College of Atmospheric Sciences, Lanzhou University since 2005. Dr. Fu's research fields are in the areas of light scattering and radiative transfer, parameterization of atmospheric radiation and cloud processes, cloud/aerosol/radiation/climate interactions, atmospheric remote sensing, and climate change detection. Dr. Fu has authored more than 120 refereed journal papers, which were cited

more than 4800 times in total and 645 times in the year of 2012, with a H-factor of 35 (Web of Knowledge, 4/9/2013). Dr. Qiang Fu is an elected fellow of the American Meteorological Society.
