

Renguang Wu – Professor of the Chinese University of Hong Kong



Renguang Wu is currently a professor at the Chinese University of Hong Kong. He graduated from the University of Hawaii in 1999. He worked in the University of Hawaii for about 3 years (1999-2002) and in the Center for Ocean-Land-Atmosphere Studies (COLA) during 2002-2010.

Renguang Wu's research interests include climate variability and climate change, atmosphere-ocean interactions, monsoon-ocean relations, and tropospheric biennial oscillations. He has published more than 90 papers in referred journals with about 40 papers as the leading author. He is currently acting as an editor of Journal of Climate.
